130 Canning Factory Rd., Grafton  
June 3:10-4 **SATURDAY ONLY**

Tour a once derelict 1904 Factory that has been transformed into a beautiful modern showroom with historic charm.

**11** **Barnum House**  
10568 County Rd. 2, Grafton  
June 3 & 4: 10-4

Tour one of the finest examples of neoclassical architecture in Ontario – now faithfully restored to how it would have been in the 1820-40 period.

**12** **Roseneath Carousel**  
9109 Cty. Rd. 45, Roseneath  
June 3: 10-4 **SATURDAY ONLY**

Take a ride on the restored 1906 Carousel while listening to the beautiful music of the 1934 Wurlitzer Military Band Organ.

**13** **St. James' Anglican Church**

Tour the charming "Little White Church on the Hill" where services have been held since before Confederation. Sunday service starts at 11am—all are welcome.

Admire the intricate 1865 wood detailing and beautiful stained-glass windows created by renowned stained glass artist, Christopher Wallis.

Discover local artifacts and explore the newly renovated barn and miniature railroad that recreates the Belleville-Peterborough rail line from the 1920s.

Tour the charmingly converted 1847 schoolhouse set amongst the spectacular beauty of 4 acres of award-winning floral and herb gardens.

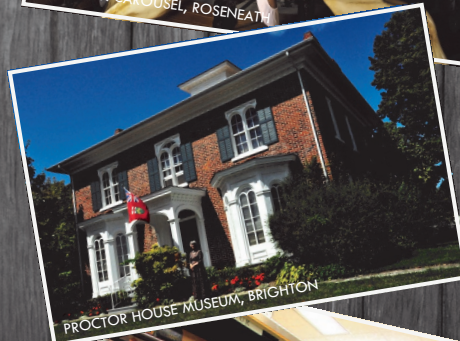
**18** **Proctor House Museum**

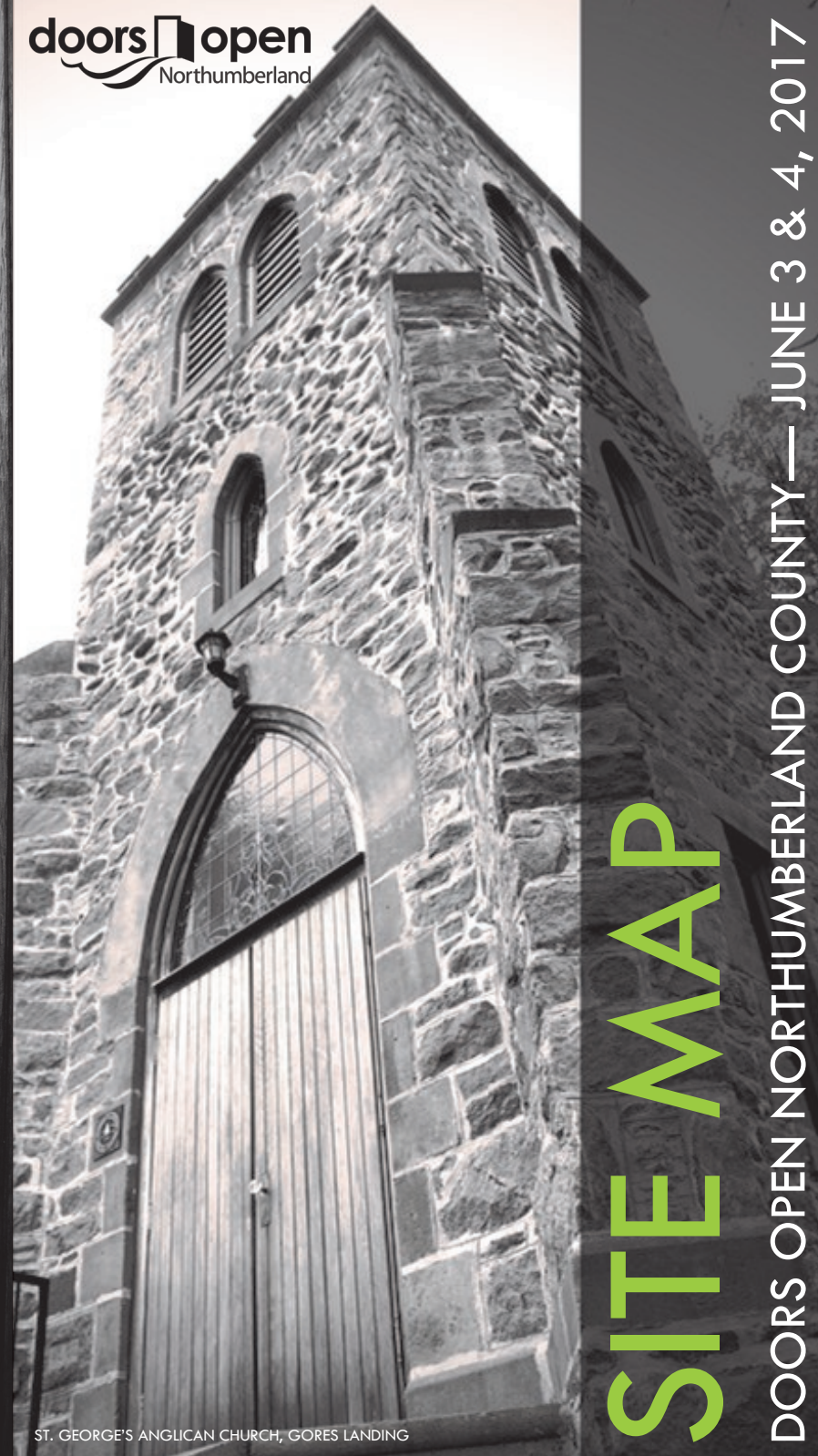

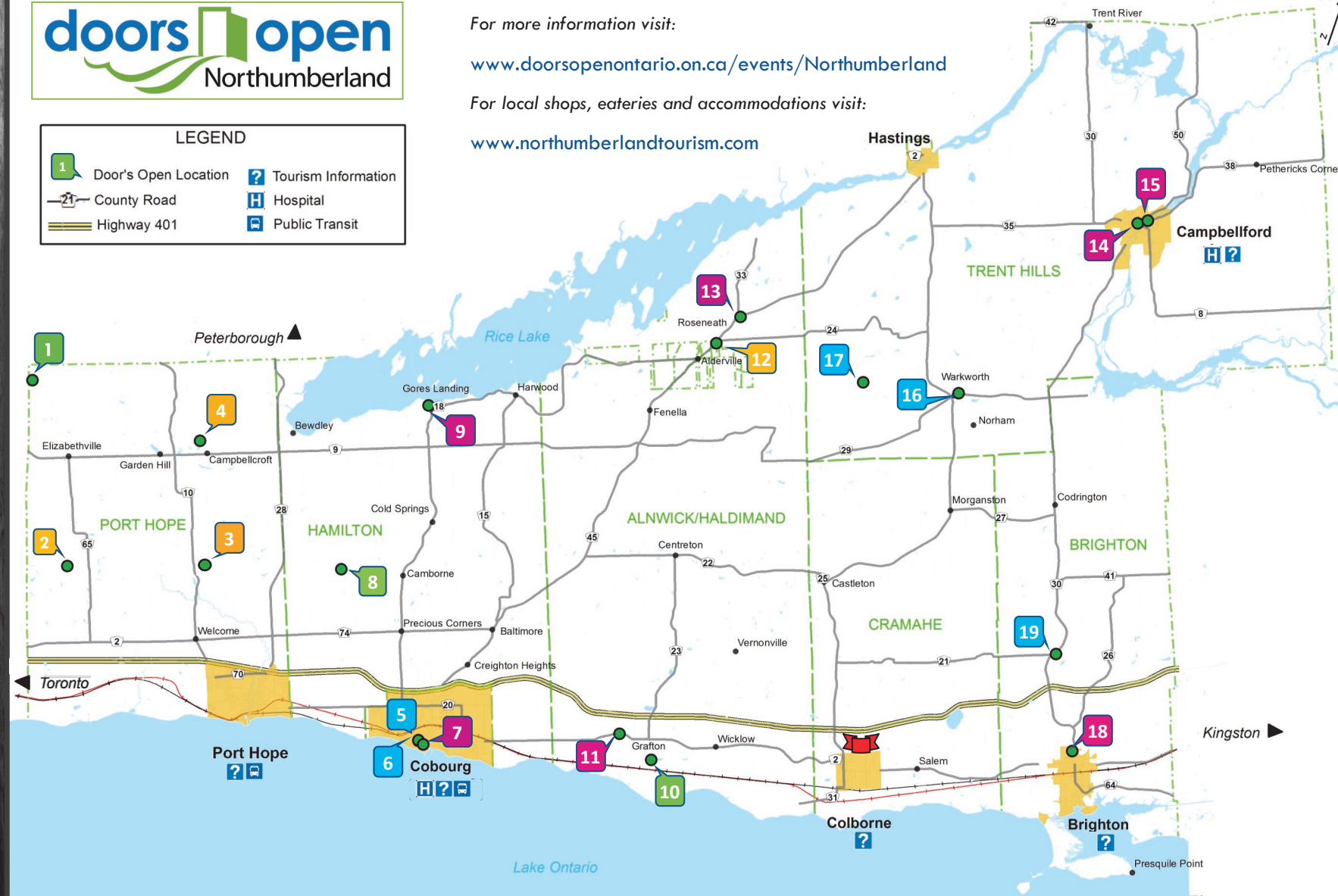
